WARNING

Adult supervision is required

- * When playing with the poppers, ensure they are kept an appropriate distance away from the eyes and face of you or another person.
- * Do not put, or attempt to launch anything on the poppers.

NOTE

This toy phone has reduced volume to adhere to safety regulations for close-to-the-ear toys.

Removing the packaging locks:



- Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- If a used battery is present, remove it from the unit by pulling up on one end of the battery.
- Install 1 new AAA (AM-4/LR03)
 battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)



5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**(◄)) or the **High Volume** (◄))
position. You will hear a song, phrases and sounds. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Volume Switch** to the **Off** (♠) position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **My Everyday Gadgets** will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be woken up again by flipping open or closing the phone, or by pressing any buttons.

NOTE

If the unit powers down during play, please install a brand new battery.

ACTIVITIES

1. Flipping Phone

Flip the phone open to enter App Mode. Close the phone to enter Animal Mode. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. App Mode

When in App Mode, press the Light Up App Buttons for fun app content, songs, melodies and to learn colours. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Animal Mode

When in Animal Mode, press the Squishy Animal Poppers to learn animal names, hear animal sounds and call the animal friends. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. Soft Poppers

Press the double-sided squishy soft poppers for press & pop play.



5. Baby's Car Keys

Press the car key buttons for silly sounds. Feel the different textures on the keys to stimulate the senses. Baby can use the bear teether to soothe sore gums.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- Remove the battery if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
- Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- If the unit still does not work, install a brand new battery.
