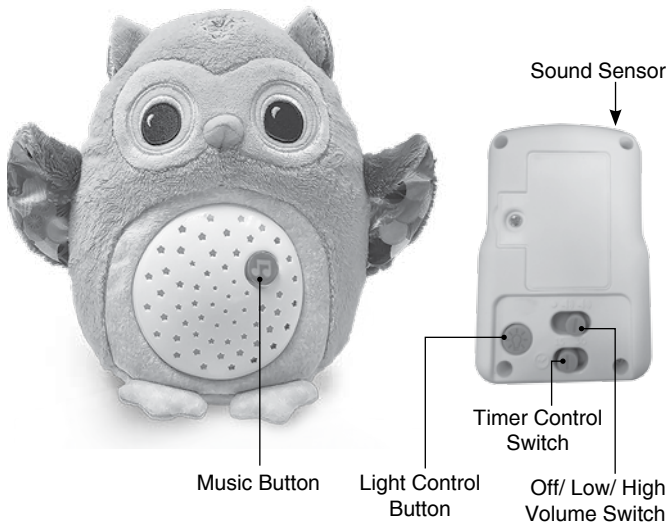

Songs, melodies, nature sounds and gentle white noise soothes and relaxes little ones while the soft and textured fabrics provide tactile stimulation. Owls Heart Button triggers calming sounds, 3 songs and melodies. Owl responds when baby cries by playing one of the 33 soothing melodies.

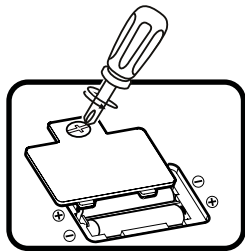
## WARNING:

# GETTING STARTED

## Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



## WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metal-hydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

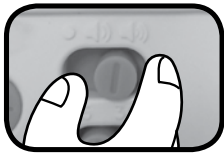

## PRODUCT FEATURES

### 1. Off/ Low/ High Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **Off/ Low/ High Volume Switch** located on the electronic module to the Low volume (🔊) or High volume (🔊🔊) position.

You will hear a sound, a phrase, three songs and 15 melodies. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off/ Low/ High Volume Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the Twinkle Lights Owl will automatically power down after the selected time. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Music Button** or when the sound sensor detects baby's cry.

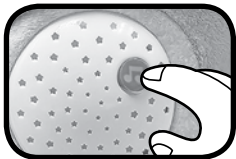
### NOTE:

This product is in try-me mode in the packaging. To activate normal play, turn the unit Off, then turn the unit to the Low volume (🔊) or High volume (🔊🔊) position. If the unit continuously powers down or the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

# ACTIVITIES

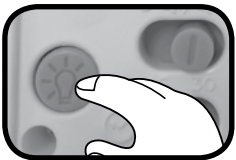
## 1. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to hear 3 soothing songs followed by soft melodies, nature sounds and gentle white noise. Press the **Music Button** again to pause the sounds. This action will put the owl into sleep mode. You can only exit this mode by pressing the **Music Button** again. The light will fade in and out slowly with the sounds.



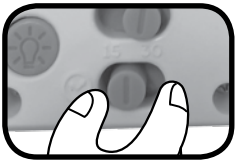
## 2. Light Control Button

Press the **Light Control Button** to adjust the light intensity levels.



## 3. Timer Control Switch

Slide the **Timer Control Switch** to select the desired preset time. Once the chosen timer has finished, the unit will enter sleep mode. If baby cry's the owl will exit sleep mode. Choose between the 15 or 30 minute timer.



## 4. Sound Sensor

When the Owl is in sleep mode, soft melodies will play if baby's cry is detected. The sensor cannot be activated after being activated for more than 10 times in a row.
