

- ② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.






Before handing the toy to your child, cut the strip that connects the toy to the box. The rope is not part of the toy and must be removed for safety.


GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the truck. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.







WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to **Low Volume ♠) or High Volume ♠)**You will hear a playful song, a cute phrase and sounds. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Off** ♠ position.



2. Pull Cord

To convert the **Building Buddies Truck** from a push toy to a pull toy, remove the pull cord from the battery compartment and thread it through the eyelet on the bottom of the truck. For your child's safety we suggest you store the pull cord in the compartment until your child is walking and to supervise your child when playing with the pull cord.

3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Building Buddies Truck** will automatically power down after approximately 65 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Tool Buttons

Press one of the **Tool Buttons** to learn the name of the tool, and hear tool sounds, playful phrases and music. The lights will flash with the sounds.



2. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** or press the **Crane Arm** when the Crane is sitting on the back of the truck to trigger the music button to hear songs, fun sounds and music. The lights will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
